<h3>Notices</h3> <p><b>Non-compliant Browsers</b></p>	<p>Beginning October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, we no longer allow connections to webservices that utilize TLS 1.0 or 1.1 (<a href="https://wbs.verisae.com">https://wbs.verisae.com</a>, <a href="https://wbs.verisae.co.uk">https://wbs.verisae.co.uk</a>), and will only accept connections using TLS 1.2.</p> <p>There are many security reasons to upgrade to newer TLS protocols. Vulnerabilities in both 1.0 and 1.1 make it more difficult for Accruent to ensure our customer data's confidentiality and integrity, as well as the availability of our services. If we believe you are impacted, we will connect with you soon and you will need to engage with your IT department to ascertain next steps to ensure you are upgraded to TLS 1.2 to ensure your connections to our webservices remains intact. In the meantime, please reach out to your CSM if you have any questions.</p>

VXERM-932	<b>Update the SIC Rules table to new Smart Table</b>	New tools are available to copy and update the status of SIC rules. The rules are copied but input as inactive. These tools allow clients to quickly create similar rules, allowing for edits and quick changes in status.
VXERM-931	<b>Add provider options to the SIC rules</b>	We updated SIC rules to allow for defining the provider by rule for assignment when the SIC is generated. This affects any automatic work orders created by the SIC creation process. The rules that exist already now default to the current preferred provider.

## Issue maintenance

Case number	Issue summary
VXERM-930	We updated the <b>Mobile System Status</b> page to show the values based on the timeframe selected by the user. We removed the <b>Events past 12 months</b> column. The page header now indicates the filter in place. The refrigerant amounts, events counts, tCO2e value, and leak rate columns are all updated. The <b>Rolling</b> and <b>Projected</b> leak rate columns are not affected.
